Introduction

The Keep Singapore Clean (KSC) Movement in Schools was launched in 2014, as a student-driven and school-supported effort for students to take ownership of the cleanliness of their school and the environment.

Through Character and Citizenship Education (CCE) and the daily cleaning, students learn about the values of responsibility and care. The KSC Movement in Schools will allow students to put these values into practice – to be responsible for keeping the places they frequent clean, such as the classroom, the school compound, or common areas in the neighbourhood, and these actions show care for the people living and working around them.
